Paint Chip Challenge Rules



1. Use one or more of the colors from the paint chip you drew to make anything you wish.
2. You may use one additional color.
3. You may use neutrals: SEE NOTE BELOW
4. If using a print, the predominate color must be the color on your paint chip.
5. Judging will be done by members at the March 2017 meeting. The following criteria will be used.
 - a. Primary color of the entry is closest to the paint chip color.
 - b. Workmanship
 - c. Visual appeal.
6. Your project **MUST** be complete and you **MUST** have the paint chip attached.
7. Please participate.

What is a "neutral"?

Neutral is not just white or beige. It is basically all the colors that do not appear on the color wheel. All the shades of white to cream, beige to brown, and even gray to black.
